- Go to the moon or the bottom of the ocean?*
- Travel to the future or the past?*

Think about and discuss the contrast to the people in God's will in chapter one verses the people in chapter two. Some may question Rahab's occupation, use your best judgment and knowledge of your family dynamics to answer these questions. For younger kids, a simple "Her job was something very sinful" might be enough to curb curiosity until they are mature enough to handle the conversation.
