

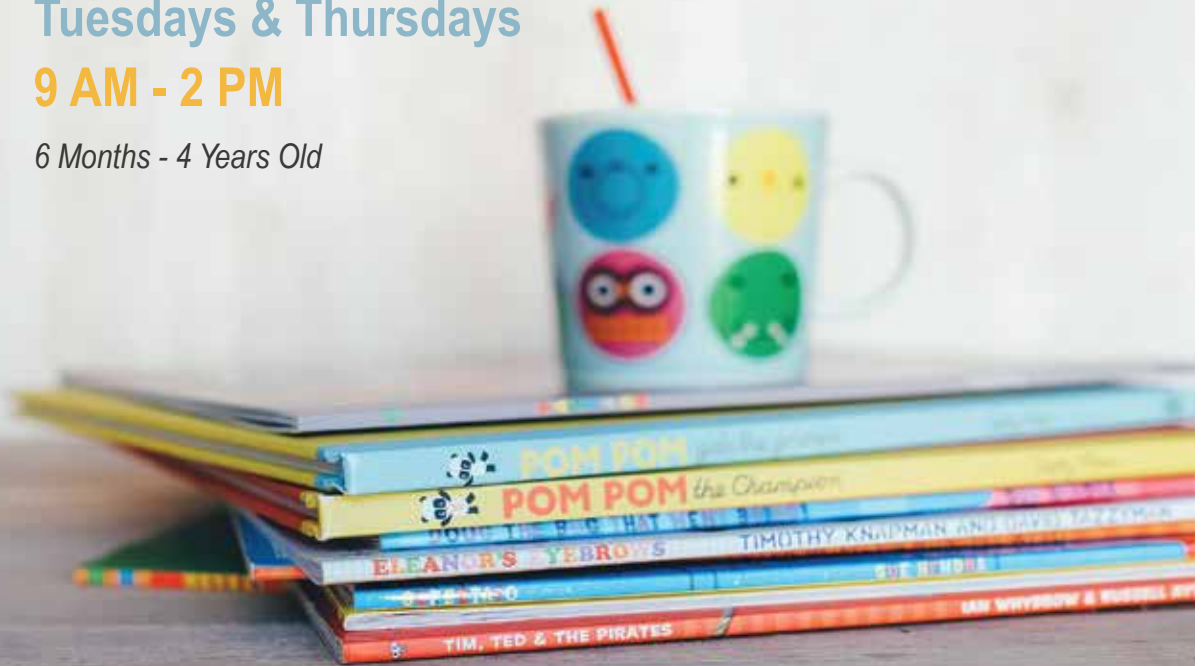

REGISTRATION FEE & TUITION

(Due on the first day of class each month)

ANNUAL

\$50 PER CHILD // \$80 PER FAMILY

Non-Refundable. This fee helps to buy supplies such as snacks, wipes, craft supplies, curriculum, etc.

MONTHLY

\$160 PER CHILD (BOTH DAYS)

15% discount for second child in the same family
We do not offer a one-day a week option.

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

CHBC Parents Day Out Program is a weekday program for children ages 6 months to 4 years old. Our program will be open on Tuesday and Thursday with a limited enrollment. All classes will meet from 9:00am till 2:00pm. Each classroom will have two teachers.

CURRICULUM

All of our teachers will be utilizing a Christian based curriculum from the youngest age to the oldest child in our program. All children will be encouraged to participate in our activities as we teach them consideration, kindness, sharing and concern for others. All of our children will be taught in a positive Christian learning environment.

FEES

- **Tuition is due on the first day of class each month.** We will accept online payments, cash or check. A \$10 late fee will be added to the tuition after the 10th of the month. There will be a \$15 fee for returned checks. Our program costs do not allow us to refund any portion of the tuition due to a child's absence. Bad weather days are non-refundable.
- Classes begin at 9:00am and end at 2:00pm. Our teachers will be preparing for the day before 9:00am so please do not drop off your child before that time. Please understand that many of our teachers have children they need to pick up from school in the afternoon and need to leave on time. We ask that you please be diligent and prompt in dropping off and picking up your child on time.
- We do not accept IOU's for payments.
- At 2:05pm, the doors will be locked. This will indicate that a late fee is in effects. You will be required to pay a late fee charge of \$1.00 per child for every minute you are late in picking up your child from the program. This charge will be added to the next month's tuition dues. Please keep in mind that many of our teachers have their own children to pick up from school and need to leave on time. Therefore, we ask that you be diligent and prompt in picking up your child. If, however, an emergency occurs (flat tire, wreck, medical condition) please call and let us know.
- A **two week notice** is required if you chose to withdrawal from our program.



PARENT POLICY & PROCEDURES

1. Children must be fully potty trained to be in our 3-year-old and 4-year-old rooms. This includes no diapers or pull-ups. No exceptions.
2. All toys & stuffed animals must be kept at home. The only exception is a blanket or small stuffed animal that can be used for rest time only and will remain in the child's cubby throughout the day.
3. If you have custody of your child, and have a court order showing that the non-custodial parents or anyone else cannot have access to your child, please provide us with a copy of the court order.
4. If anyone, other than the people listed on your "pick up list", is picking up your child let the teacher and director know. We will ask that person to provide a photo ID before your child will be released.
5. There should be no one in the classroom except for the teachers, staff and enrolled children. Every teacher and staff member has passed, and has on file, a background check. All doors in and out of the building will be locked for your child's safety.
6. Do not bring your child to class if he/she has a fever of 99 degrees or higher. They must be without fever, medication, vomiting and/or diarrhea within the last 24 hours before they can return to the program. Illness guidelines will be provided on the last page.
7. Your child should wear comfortable play clothes. They will be painting, gluing and playing outdoors.
8. Your child will need a lunch and nap mat each day. Please label these things along with coats and any other personal items your child brings to the program. Please do not send any foods that require warming or refrigeration, with the exception of bottles.
9. If you wish to bring cookies, cake or cupcakes on your child's birthday, please notify the teachers in advance and check for any allergies. Please bring store bought goodies only.
10. We will observe the same weather days as the Mustang Public Schools. If the schools are closed because of weather, we will be cancelled.

11. We prefer teachers not to administer medication to your child. You may come and give your child medicine as needed. Special considerations may be given depending on the situation. Please talk with the director if your child needs medication.

12. Teachers are trained in age-appropriate discipline methods. Parents will be informed if inappropriate behavior continues after approved methods of discipline are tried.

BITING POLICY

By 18 months of age, children are old enough to be taught that biting hurts and to make better choices. Our teachers will work with the child that is biting by redirecting them. The teacher can use time-away from the group for one minute per year of age. If those methods show no improvement, parents will be notified and the child will be suspended for one week of class so this behavior can be worked on at home. If the child returns to the program and continues to bite, the child will need to take a break from attending our preschool program until the biting has stopped. **This same procedure will be followed for children who hit, push, scratch, or otherwise inflict injury on other children or teachers.

ILLNESS GUIDE

Children who are ill or contagious cannot be brought to our preschool program. If your child is exposed to anyone in the home with a fever of 100.4 or greater (strep, flu, stomach bug, etc.) we ask that child to stay home until the household is fever free. Please call/text the director if your child will not be present. A parent will be asked to pick up their child if symptoms begin or observed during the day. Your child must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to the program.

Some Common Symptoms Include

- Yellow/green discharge from the nose/eyes/ears
- Contagious skin rash (boils, ringworm, poison ivy, etc.)
- Lice (child must be both nit and lice free)
- Strep throat or inflamed mouth or throat
- Mumps, measles, whooping cough, chicken pox, pneumonia

- Fever (over 99 degrees)
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea
- Croup or persistent cough
- Pink eye

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COVID-19 POLICY

If your child is directly exposed to **COVID-19**, they must quarantine for 14 days. Please contact the director and let her know that exposure has taken place and the child will not be at PDO for 14 days. Your information will be kept confidential.

If the director, a teacher, or a child in our PDO program tests positive for COVID-19 the entire program will shut down for 14 days for the CDC recommended quarantine period. All paid tuition will be credited to the next month.

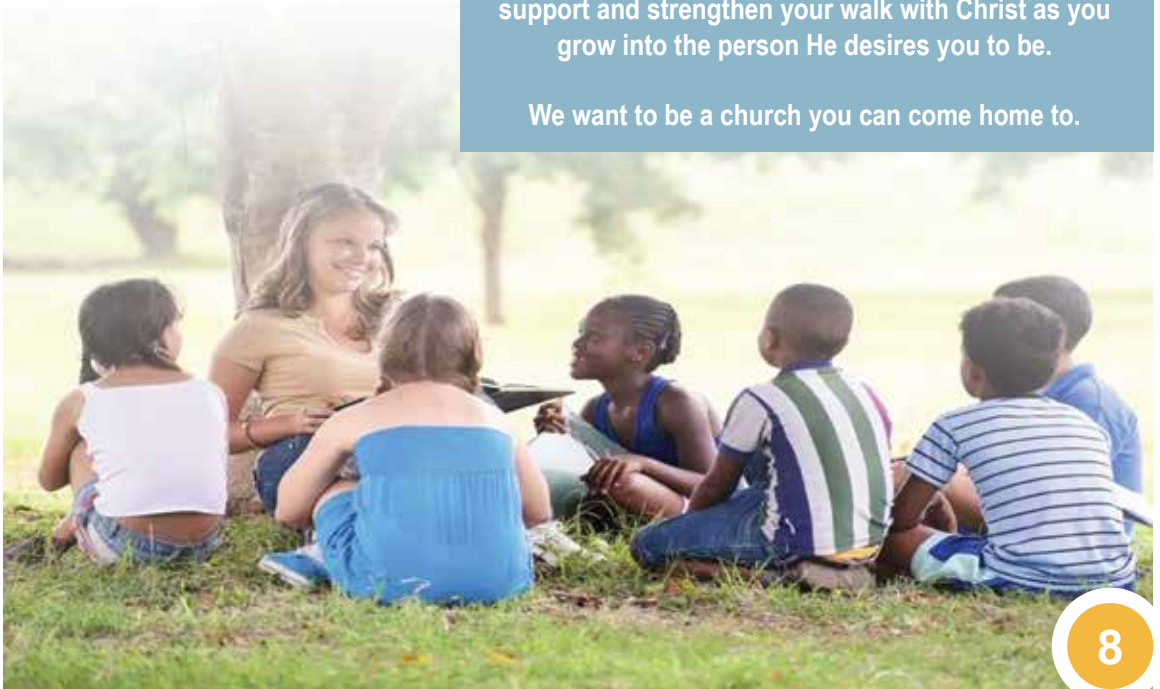
Church Membership
